FOOD BANKS CANADA HUNGER COUNT

The annual Hunger Count was released last week. There were 1,935,911 visits made to Foodbanks in the past year. Usage has increased by 32.1% compared to last year. Alberta is third in usage, behind Ontario and Quebec. One third of foodbank clients are children.
